# NEWSPAPER COLLECTIONS

Arlington County is collecting old newspapers separately from other trash every two weeks on a regular trash pick-up day. The unsoiled newspapers should be placed at curbside, either tied in bundles not exceeding 50 lbs. (about 18" high) or put untied in brown paper grocery bags, not in plastic bags or cardboard boxes.

The county has contracted with Browning-Ferris Industries for pick-up of newspapers. Collection trucks will start at 6:30 a.m. These vehicles will be blue with a large white sign on the side reading "Arlington County Resource Recovery Program." Anyone seeing other vehicles collecting the paper is asked to get the license number and call the Arlington County Police.

Costs of newspaper collection will be partially defraved by having smaller loads of refuse to haul to the Lorton landfill, where Arlington County now disposes of its trash. We save \$41 in collecting and hauling costs for every ton collected, plus we are helping in the environmental effort.
