1. Metrorail

Shall Arlington County contract a debt and issue its general obligation bonds in the maximum amount of \$13,000,000 pursuant to the Public Finance Act, as amended, together with other available funds, to fund the County's share of construction and acquisition of Metrorail facilities by the Washington Metropolitan Areas Transit Authority?

2. Streets and Highways

Shall Arlington County contract a debt and issue its general obligation bonds in the maximum amount of \$3,100,000 pursuant to the Public Finance Act, as amended, to finance, together with other available funds, the cost of acquiring, construction, landscaping, and improving streets, highways, curbs, gutters, pedestrian ways, street lights and bikeways, including any associated storm drainage improvements?

3. Community Conservation

Shall Arlington County contract a debt and issue its general obligation bonds in the maximum amount of \$1,950,000 pursuant to the Public Finance Act, as amended, to finance, together with other available funds, the cost of improvements pursuant to County Board conservation plans for residential and commercial areas and the cost of other community improvements, including constructing and improving pedestrian ways, curbs, gutters and streets; installing lighting facilities; constructing drainage improvements; park development; landscaping; and underground utilities.

4. Water Distribution

Shall Arlington County contract a debt and issue its general obligation bonds in the maximum amount of \$3,100,000 pursuant to the Public Finance Act, as amended, to finance, together with other available funds, the cost of expansion and improvements to the Arlington water distribution system.
